

Privacy Statement

Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) Web site and governs data collection and usage. By using the Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.



Collection of Your Personal Information

Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP/Postal code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favourites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS). This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Web site addresses. This information is used by Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) Web site.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others. Use of Your Personal Information

Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) collects and uses your personal information to operate the Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) Web site and deliver the services you have requested. Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) also uses your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) and its affiliates. Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS), and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) keeps track of the Web sites and pages our customers visit within Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS), in order to determine what Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Canadian North Sea Energy (CNS) to customers whose behaviour indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Use of Cookies

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page.
